Looking to the future of Plainwell Community Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. If approved by voters, it would provide \$48,655,000 for district-wide improvements.

At the Community Center, improvements would include:

- Renovations to comply with current building codes, including A.D.A. accessibility
- Upgrading toilet rooms
- Upgrading ventilation
- Egress improvements
- Fire alarm system
- Secure vestibule addition
- Upgrading lighting to LED and adding exterior lighting
- The fire alarm system and code-required upgrades must be made in order for this building to support alternative education, adult education and other community programming
- \$943,299 total project cost
