

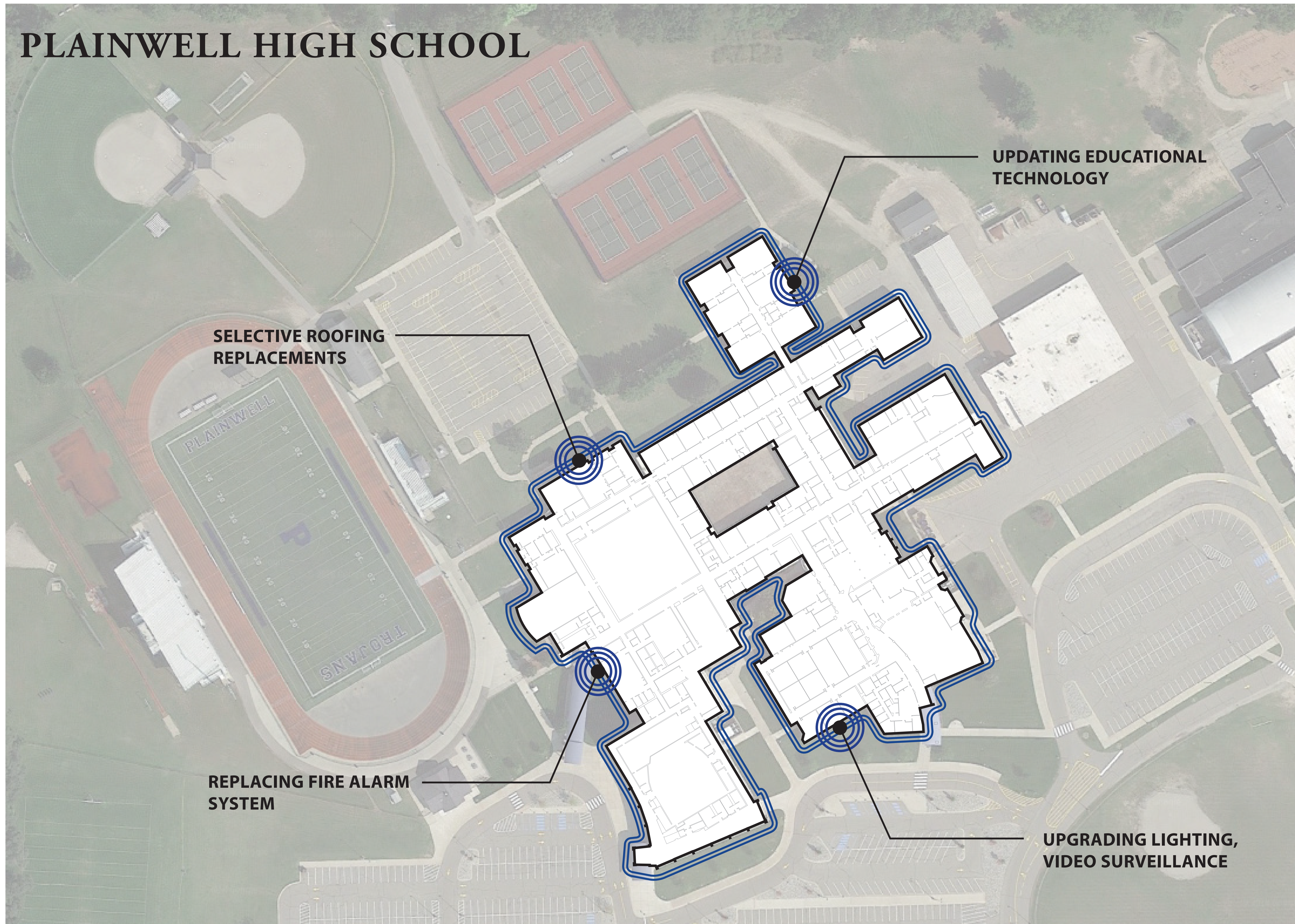


BOND PROPOSAL IMPROVEMENTS

Looking to the future of Plainwell Community Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. If approved by voters, it would provide \$48,655,000 for district-wide improvements.

At the High School, improvements would include:

- Updating selective educational technology including student devices and classroom multimedia
- Replacing fire alarm system to help improve building safety
- Increasing video surveillance
- Upgrading selective lighting to help reduce energy costs
- Replacing selective roofing
- \$1,173,589 total project cost*

*All bond project costs are estimates and subject to change based upon actual construction costs. Total project costs for all projects will not exceed \$48,655,000.
